

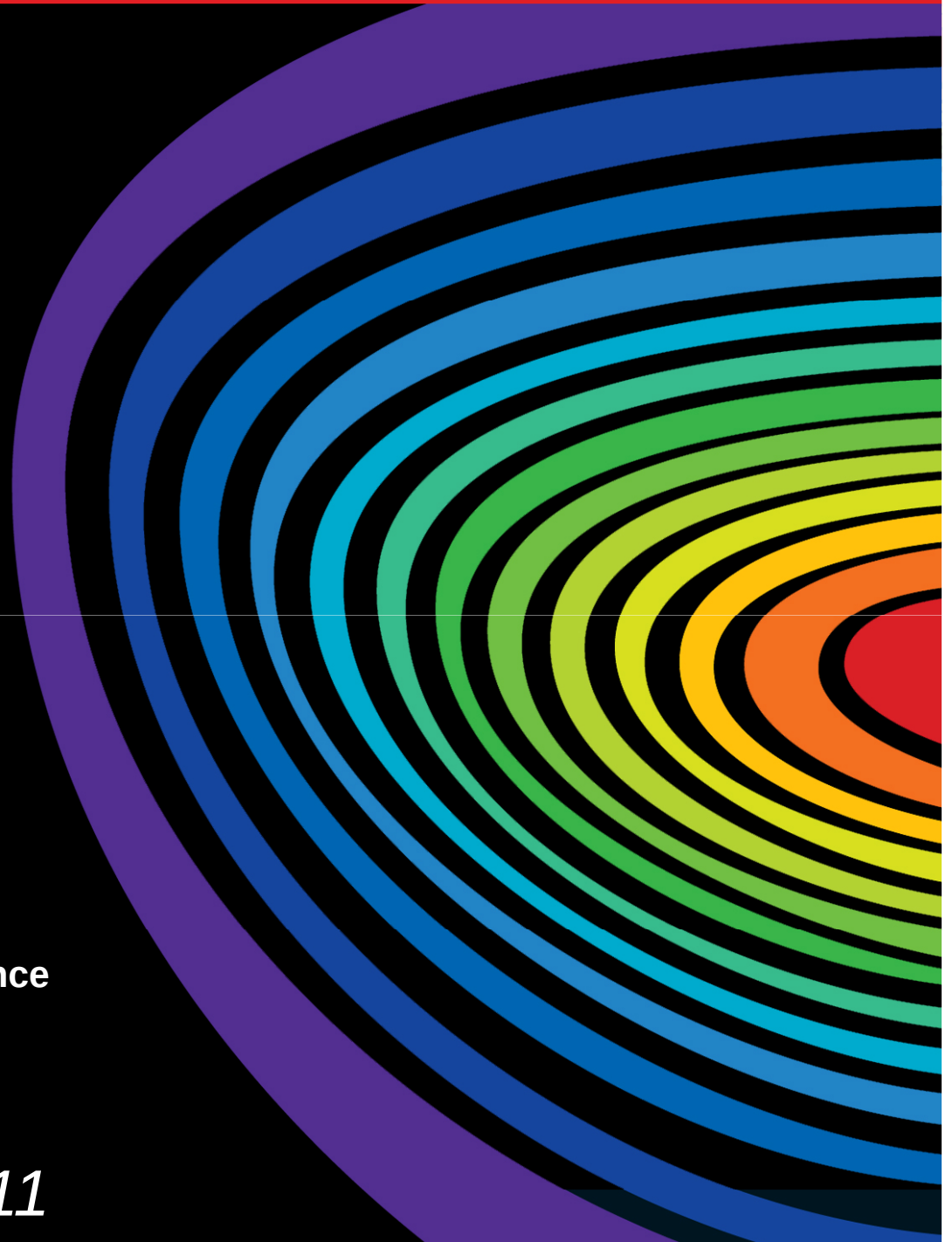

IOP consortia worldwide

- IOP Publishing in brief:
 - International learned society, since 1874
 - Education
 - Influence governments
 - Scientific reports
 - Member groups and services
- A leading publisher in physical sciences
 - Over 60 journals, owned by IOP and partners
 - Offices in UK, USA, Russia, Poland, China, Japan, and Germany
 - Readers and authors in over 180 countries



IOP consortia worldwide

- More consortia year on year:
 - 33 licenses in 2003
 - 67 licenses in 2005
 - 73 licenses in 2006
 - 92 licenses in 2008
 - Over 100 licenses in 2011
- Advantages of a consortium at a country level:
 - All members accessing the same information
 - Cost, if any, is shared therefore better value
 - Difficult to prove, but link between greater resources and higher level of activity does exist.

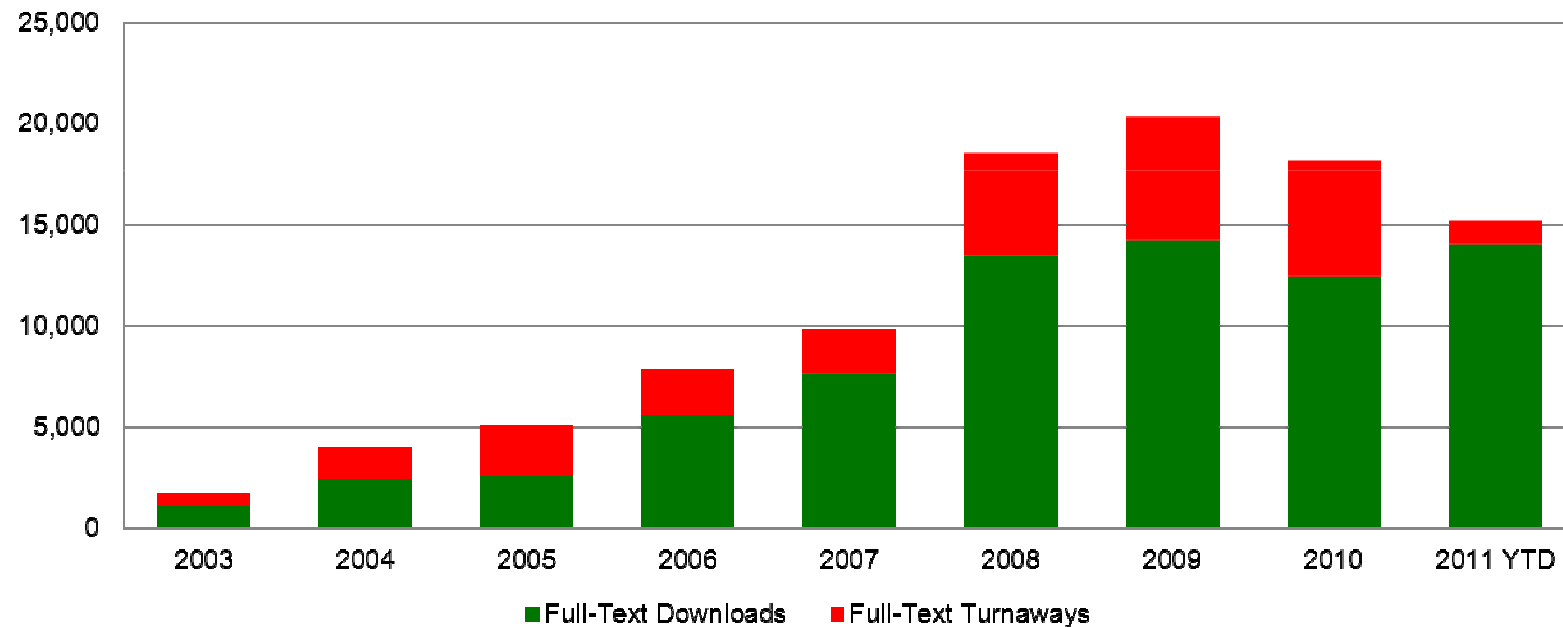


LMBA License to IOP titles

- It all started in 2006
 - eIFL license model
 - 39 titles included in 2006
 - By 2010 the eIFL license had 54 titles
 - 5 member institutions in LMBA since 2006, however huge increase in usage over the years
 - Stable pricing provided

Total Full-text Requests per year 2003-11 YTD





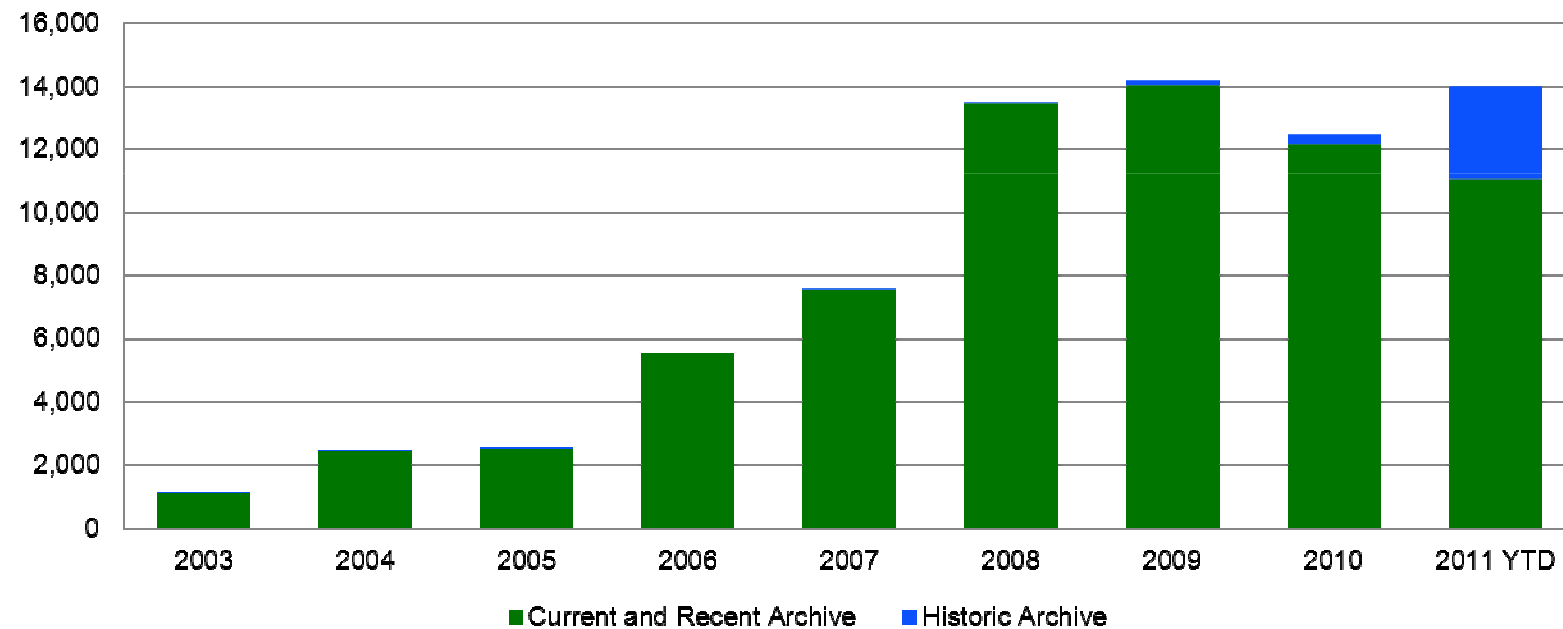
IOP archive 1874-2000

- In December 2010 LMBA acquired the IOP archive
- One-off purchase of the entire 1874-2000 collection
- Usage already demonstrating that the resource is proving very popular with users
 - 3,000 downloads out of 14,000 so far
- The license asked IOP to provide a local load...
